3.6.3.3 Training of Caregivers/Teachers to Administer Medication Any caregiver/teacher who administers medication should complete a standardized training course that includes skill and competency assessment in medication administration. The course should be repeated according to state and/or local regulation and taught by a trained professional.

Participate in medication reconciliation process. Titrate dosage of medication based on assessment and ordered parameters (e.g., giving insulin according to blood glucose levels, titrating medication to maintain a specific blood pressure) Dispose of unused medications according to facility/agency policy.

Administer high-alert intravenous medication infusions via a programmable infusion device utilizing dose error-reduction software. Reconcile the patient's medications at each care transition and when a new medication is ordered to reduce the risk for medication errors, including omissions, duplications, dosing errors, and drug interactions.
