Life safety issues are also high on the accreditor's list of findings; The Joint Commission reported that 0.7% of its hospital findings represented an immediate threat to health or safety, while 8.3% of its findings had a high likelihood to harm a patient, staff member, or hospital visitor (The Joint Commission, 2018).
