Brass refers to the metal insignia used to indicate cadet rank and ROTC affiliation (ROTC crest for cap, ROTC letters, and ROTC torch). Gig-line refers to the line formed by the uniform shirt opening, the edge of the belt buckle, and the zipper flap on the uniform trousers.

### CHAPTER 4: THE MILITARY UNIFORM UNIFORMS GENERAL.

ROTC Cadets may wear the issue uniform within the United States and its possessions when-- (1) Assembling for the purpose of military instruction. (2) Engaging in the military instruction of a Cadet Corps or similar organization. (3) Traveling to and from the institution in which enrolled.

Each year approximately 6000 cadet across all of Army ROTC enter their final year of their college degree program. Of those 6000 cadets approximately 2000 chose to go into the National Guard or Army Reserve and "opt out" of Active Duty. Approximately 4000 cadets each year request to compete for selection onto Active Duty.

The Command relationships within Army ROTC are as follows: US Army Cadet Command (USACC) is commanded by a Major General and is responsible for Eight Brigades.
