Can't change Screen Resolution in Windows 10

On the Advanced display settings screen, select the monitor you want to change the resolution for. You should know which monitor is which from the first step. If you skipped it, there is an Identify link on this screen too. Use it to identify your monitor. Select the monitor you want to set a different resolution for. This is a crucial step because the resolution options in the dropdown change depending on which display you've selected.

How To Set Different Resolutions For Multiple Monitors In ...

In my example setup, I have a 14-inch laptop with a 1920x1080 screen resolution, and a 24-inch monitor with a 1920x1200 resolution. Windows can detect the difference in sizes and adjust itself accordingly: it's set the laptop to 150% visual scale (on-screen items are 50% larger than standard) and 100%, or default, for the monitor.

How to Adjust Scaling for Different Monitors In Windows 10

Select your desired resolution, click on the Change button and hit the keyboard shortcut keys you want to assign. For example, I assigned Ctrl + Shift + Alt + L to a lower screen resolution (set to 1366 x 768) which is beneficial for me when I'm reading an ebook or have opened only one application.

3 Ways To Change Screen Resolution In Windows 10

In Windows 10, the process of adjusting or changing screen resolution is extremely simple. Only you have to right-click on your computer screen and select " Display Settings " option and then from the " Resolution " section, select the resolution you want for your Windows 10 computer screen.

Choose the monitor from the list in the dialog box and then make the resolution settings. A humongous difference exists between the display resolution and the image resolution. The image resolution is the number of dots per inch (dpi) used to render the image. The amount can vary. PC monitors are set at about 96 dots per inch, which is why some images appear small on the screen and others appear huge.
