#### When to Punctuate Titles in Italics or Quotes

Use quotation marks around the title if it is part of a larger work (e.g. a chapter of a book, an article in a journal, or a page on a website). All major words in a title are capitalized. The same format is used in Works Cited list and in the text itself. Place in quotation marks. Italicize.

#### MLA Titles | How to Format and Capitalize Source Titles

There are two main ways to format an in-text citation: Parenthetical citation or Narrative citation. Parenthetical citation: Put all the citation information at the end of the sentence: Narrative citation: Include some of the citation information as part of the sentence: Each source cited in-text must also be listed in your References list.

You may want to include the title of an article in your paper when it is the main subject you're writing about, a subject you're discussing that you're referring to simply as an example, or if the research for your writing isn't extensive enough to require a citation page. The American Psychological Association (APA) has specific guidelines on how to include an article title in the text of your writing.

#### How to Add an Article Title Into the Text Using APA Format ...

If the source used is part of a larger work, for example, a chapter or essay, the title should be placed in quotation marks and this title should be followed by a period in the end. It is then followed by the title of the larger work in italics, and a comma at the end. For example:

Note: Titles of periodicals, books, brochures, or reports should be in italics and use normal title capitalization rules. If you are citing multiple sources by multiple authors in-text, you can list all of them by the author's last name and year of publication within the same set of parentheses, separated by semicolons.

#### How do I refer to a book by title in-text in APA format ...

These differences mostly extend to the title page and running head. Crucially, citation practices do not differ between the two styles of paper. If you want to cite a special issue of a journal rather than a regular article, the name (s) of the editor (s) and the title of the issue appear in place of the author's name and article title: Note that if you want to cite an individual article from the special issue, it can just be cited as a regular article.

#### How to Cite a Journal Article in APA Style | Format & Examples

The title of the paper is written in title case, meaning that most adjectives, nouns, and verbs are capitalized, but articles and conjunctions are not. Titles are enclosed in quotation marks. Include the type of paper after the title. For example: "Kringle, Kris, and Jack Frost.

The Chicago Manual of Style's Rule 14.225 says, "Titles of unpublished manuscripts, like the titles of other unpublished works, appear in quotation marks. (For manuscripts under contract but not yet published, see 14.153.)

#### How to Reference Books and Articles in Text - Grammar and ...

For all pages of the paper, including the APA format title page, include the "TITLE OF YOUR PAPER" justified to the left in capital letters (i.e., the running head). If your full title is long (over 50 characters), the running head title should be a shortened version. 6.
