CST, or 'Cognitive Stimulation Therapy', is a brief treatment for people with mild to moderate dementia. 'Dementia' is an umbrella term, the two main types being Alzheimer's and Vascular dementia. CST was designed following extensive evaluation of research evidence, hence is an evidence-based treatment ( 1 ).

Cognitive Stimulation Therapy, CST, is an evidence-based group intervention for people with mild to moderate dementia. Usually a group of up to ten people meet once or twice a week for 14 weeks. Your coordinator will plan themed activities that aim to provide stimulation for thinking, concentration and memory.

There are a number of interventions or approaches to help people with dementia improve their memory and thinking skills to enable them to cope better with memory loss. One of the interventions for which there is most evidence in terms of clinical and cost- effectiveness is Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST).

### Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST): summary of evidence ...

The results of the trial showed that CST led to significant benefits in people's cognitive functioning, as measured by the Mini-Mental State Examination (MMSE) and the ADAS-COG. These tests primarily investigate memory and orientation, but also language and visuospatial abilities.
