- Saline solution of various sizes such as 100 mL or 1L bags.

The ACLS crash cart requires equipment and medications, each organized in such a way that they are readily accessible during an emergency. The crash cart itself is designed to be highly mobile and compact, despite all of the life-saving supplies.

### **The ACLS Crash Cart Requirements: What You Need to Know**

A crash cart contains the equipment and medications that would be required to treat a patient in the first thirty minutes or so of a medical emergency. Although crash carts can differ somewhat depending upon their location, the basic crash cart will contain similar equipment.

Calling 911 is critical, but in the meantime, all medical offices must be prepared with devices and

### **What Medical Offices Need to Know about Crash Carts ...**

Basically, a crash cart is a specially designed wheeled chest of drawers, or a trolley that contains life-saving drugs and equipment. Carts are often positioned in intensive care units/emergency rooms, or places where these are easily accessible to the doctors. The contents of a crash cart help the doctors handle an emergency.

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### **How a Medical Office Can Be Ready for a Pediatric Medical ...**

In-patient crash cart medication drawers shall be restocked according to the form "Pharmaceutical Med/Surg, Crash Cart Check List" (Appendices). Carts shall be restocked with medications that are to expire no sooner than 6 months from date of restocking.
