To insert a pivot table, all you need to do is to select your list of values (including headers) and click insert pivot table button from insert ribbon. If your list is formatted as a table, then clicking on any single cell in table is sufficient for pivot table to include all your values.

To start off, select any cell in the data and click Pivot Table on the insert tab of the ribbon: Excel will display the Create Pivot Table window. Notice the data range is already filled in. The default location for a new pivot table is New Worksheet.
