Ethical Reasoning Rubric. Ethical Reasoning is reasoning about right and wrong human conduct. It requires students to be able to assess their own ethical values and the social context of problems, recognize ethical issues in a variety of settings, think about how different ethical perspectives might be applied to ethical dilemmas, and consider the ramifications of alternative actions.

RF- In grade 1, students applied grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words. Creating and Using Rubrics | Assessment and Curriculum ...

Student adequately mimics designated genre style of writing to a current cultural issue incorporating an effective and clearly understandable use of symbolism by using fairy tale elements, motifs, and characteristics. Student partially incorporates the elements, motifs, and characteristics of the Fairy Tale into their own story.

iRubric: Modern Fairy Tale (Genre Analysis) rubric ...

Analysis: Analysis evaluates the discussion of evidence. At the lower level, is the interpretation accurate and focused? At higher level, students are expected to analyze thoughtfully, including subtle nuances while retaining clarity. Justification: Justification evaluates a student's ability to develop a link from evidence to assertion.
