In performing a behavior forensic analysis of property destruction (vandalism), clinical investigation also examines the propensity of the offender's (a) attention-seeking ratio of reinforcement, (b) manipulation of the negative reinforcement contingencies to avoid or escape adverse consequences, (c) the sensory or other automatic reinforcement generated by frequency or intensity of the destructive act, and (d) motivating operations underlying the high or low probability of vandalism occurrence.
