In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list. APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that have no page numbers, use a paragraph

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.

One way to cite a quotation, paraphrase, or other borrowed information in text is to introduce the author in the sentence. If the textbook was written by more than one author, list all the names. Only use the last name, unless there are two authors with the same last name. In that instance, include the first initial, as well.

Give the secondary source in the reference list; in text, name the original work and give a citation for the secondary source. For example, if Allport's work is cited in Nicholson and you did not read Allport's work, list the Nicholson reference in the reference list. In the text, use the following citation:

The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the end, provided it directly takes you to the full text without logging in.

Using the textbook example from Step 1, cite the parenthetical reference within the body of your text as follows: (Vanderbeck, 2009). Include the textbook in the reference list at the end of your document. Format the entry beginning with the author's last name first, followed by his or her first name.

How to Cite a Textbook Reference | Pen and the Pad

Author (s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.
