The new style of plumbing check valve has a see-thru lid, gasket sealed diverter, and the ability to open it up to replace parts or clear clogs. Like the diverter valves, the ports on Jandy check valves are also 1.5"/2" or 2"/2.5", accepting both pipe sizes, with a spigot or socket connection.

Insert the suction hose of a commercial vacuum between the vinyl liner and the wall about 4"-6" from the pool floor or approximately 20" from the top of the pool. The ball and butterfly valves both use a spinning element/insert to stop or release the flow of water with a quarter turn of the handle. Drill a 3" hole in the panel, 12" to 14" down from clockwise the top of the panel (NOT to the top of the coping). Drill from the back to eliminate hitting the cross bracing on the pool kit panels. Slide the pool return fitting through the hole inside the swimming pool wall and install the lock-nut. Tighten snugly.
