Missouri Professional Engineers are required to take 30 Professional Development hours every 24 months. All courses are subject to review by The Board of Architects, Professional Engineers, Professional Land Surveyors and Landscape Architects.

Missouri Professional Engineers License Requirements ...

Missouri Professional Engineers require 30 PDHs per biennium and are allowed up to 15 PDHs in excess of the 30 PDH requirement to be carried over to the next biennium. The biennium is based on the year of PE licensure with engineers being originally licensed in even number years to renew December 31st of even numbered years.

Rules of Department of Commerce and Insurance

Engineers in Missouri must earn 30 professional development hour credits every two years. Ethics courses are accepted but not required. Missouri does not pre-approve course providers or courses. License renewal is biennially, December 31st based on the year of initial licensure.
