Here, the photodiode is in series with the input of an op amp where ideally zero current flows. That op amp has feedback set by R1 and R2 to establish amplification of the voltage diode just as if it was an offset voltage of the amplifier. While appealing to more common op amp thinking, this voltage mode is nonlinear.
