The pollution prevention opportunity assessment is an environmental analysis tool used to evaluate processes and operations. The goal of the assessment is to: Identify and assess the amount of material disposed of as waste during a particular process or at a particular workplace;

Specifically, the pollution prevention opportunity assessment is a systematic evaluation of processes and operation to: Characterize all aspects of the process or operation, including process flow, waste generation patterns, material and power consumption, costs, manpower, reliance on toxic chemicals

The Pollution Prevention Opportunity Assessment (PPOA) summarized here was conducted at a U.S.Postal Service (USPS) Facility in Buffalo, NY. The PPOA documented and quantified waste generation at the General Mail Facility (GMF) where mail is processed, and at the Vehicle Maintenance Facility (VMF), where 1,200 postal vehicles are services and refinished.

### **EGLE - Integrated Assessment Program**

Pollution prevention (P2) is any practice that reduces, eliminates, or prevents pollution at its source, also known as "source reduction." Source reduction is fundamentally different and more desirable than recycling, treatment and disposal. There are significant opportunities for industry to reduce or prevent pollution at the source through cost-effective changes in production, operation, and raw materials use.
