Procedure of Venipuncture. The patient can be made to sit in a chair, or sitting or lying on a bed. An elastic band/ tourniquet is tied around the arm/ site. The band/tourniquet retains blood within the arm and makes the veins more visible. The patient is asked to make a fist.

Phlebotomy is also prescribed for patients with disorders that increase the amount of iron in their blood to dangerous levels, such as hemochromatosis, hepatitis B, and hepatitis C. Patients with pulmonary edema may undergo phlebotomy procedures to decrease their total blood volume.

Let the patient know that venipuncture procedure may be a little painful, but of short duration. Never say "This won't hurt a bit." Have the patient sit in the phlebotomy chair and raise or lower the chair arm accordingly. Patient arm should not be bent at the elbow. Add support under the arm with a pillow if necessary.
