Raft foundations are one of the most appropriate foundation systems in order to prevent the differential settlement particularly when column loads are large and variable. The behavior of raft foundation is either rigid and/or flexible depending on the characteristics of the soil at which the foundation rests.

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The raft foundation is a kind of combined footing that may cover the entire area under the structure supporting several columns in one rigid body. In this project, the soil profile shows that the bearing stress is around 100 kN/m². The raft foundation is usually used with this kind of soil. The columns have high axial loads.

Structural Design of Raft Foundation

Raft foundation is a thick concrete slab reinforced with steel which covers the entire contact area of the structure like a thick floor. Sometimes area covered by raft may be greater than the contact area depending on the bearing capacity of the soil underneath.

Raft Foundation Design General Considerations A mat supported on strong bedrock transmits the load in a relatively small area near columns. The pressure distribution on raft foundation will be as shown Fig. 1 (a). If the mat rests on stiff or compact soils, the mat distributes the load to the subsoil in larger areas as shown in Fig. 1 (b).

Raft foundation Foundations provide support for structures, transferring their load to layers of soil or rock that have sufficient bearing capacity and suitable settlement characteristics. Very broadly, foundations can be categorised as shallow foundations or deep foundations.

Raft foundation transmits the total load from the building to the entire ground floor area. Stress distribution mechanism of raft foundation is very simple. Total weight of the structure and self-weight of the mat is calculated and is divided by the total area of the foundation it is covering to calculate the stress on the soil.

Raft foundation is one of the types of foundation that is composed of a thick mat or slab that supports the entire structures. This type of foundation is used when there are larger column loads to support and when soil bearing capacity is too low. Raft foundations are suitable for medium rise story buildings ranges from four to twelve stories.

Advantages and Disadvantages of Raft Foundation - Civil

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The foundation consisting of a thick R.C.C slab covering the whole area of a mat is known as raft foundation. Method of

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construction of Raft Foundation: In Raft Foundation construction the whole area is dug out to the specified depth and 30 cm more wide than the area to be covered. The bed is compacted and sprinkled over with water.

C. Mat Foundation (Raft Foundation) It is a combined footing that may cover the entire area under a structure supporting several columns and walls. Mat foundations are sometimes preferred for soils that have low load-bearing capacities, but that will have to support high column or wall loads.

It is considered as one type of shallow foundation and is useful in controlling the differential settlement.
