Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 34, which governs document request responses, was revised in late 2015 to require that responses now "state with specificity the ground for objecting and state whether any responsive materials are being withheld on the basis of that objection."

## Responses to Discovery Document Requests Are Now Required ...

The purpose of the response is to clearly inform the demanding party as to what you (the responding party) are going to do for each individual RPD. The response is not intended nor designed to identify (or even actually produce) the specific documents you will be producing. 1

## Common mistakes and pitfalls in responses to Requests for ...

To respond, you first need to read each request and see if the document or object requested is in your possession, custody, or control. You then need to draft a written response in which you state what documents you will turn over and which ones you won't.

### **Responding to Unsolicited Requests for Off-Label ...**

The response may state an objection to a requested form for producing electronically stored information. If the responding party objects to a requested form—or if no form was specified in the request—the party must state the form or forms it intends to use. (E) Producing the Documents or Electronically Stored Information.

### **Rule 34. Producing Documents, Electronically Stored ...**

A response letter to a request is a letter, which is an answer to some initial letter. It provides information or relevant answer to the initial inquiry. Some people might have a certain concern, or they would like to address an issue, therefore, writing a response letter to such requests become very important.

### **Response Letter to a Request: Format (with Samples)**

Under the law, all federal agencies are required to respond to a FOIA request within 20 business days, unless there are "unusual circumstances." This time period generally begins when the request is received by the FOIA office of the Department of Justice component that maintains the records sought.

### **Responding to Requests - U.S. Department of Justice**

Responses to requests for production are due within thirty (30) days (five (5) days in unlawful detainer actions) if the requests were personally served, thirty-five (35) days if the requests were served by mail, and thirty (30) days plus two (2) court days if the requests were served by express

mail or facsimile or electronically.

### **Response to Request for Production in California Superior ...**

While producing copies of the requested documents is the more commonly used option, often the responding attorney fails to organize and label the documents to correspond with the categories in the request. Such a response fails to comport with the rules of procedure, is evasive, and therefore can be treated as a failure to respond.

### **Best practices in responding to requests for production ...**

USCIS will consider a response to the above requests and notices received within 60 calendar days after the response due date set in the request or notice before taking any action. We will consider a Form N-336 or Form I-290B received up to 60 calendar days from the date of the decision before we take any action.

### **USCIS Extends Flexibility for Responding to Agency Requests**

Responding party objects that the request seeks documents already in plaintiff's possession custody or control. Responding party objects to this request as it seeks documents that are not within defendants' possession, custody, or control. Boilerplate objections are becoming more and more common in response to each of the document requests.
