The placeholders for requirements on a Scrum project are called product backlog items, which are often expressed as user stories. These user stories can be thought of as card, conversation, and confirmation, and can be evaluated using the six criteria represented by the INVEST acronym.

User Stories User stories are the smallest units of user functionality in agile which can be delivered in one agile sprint. They are typically estimated using story pointed and defined using INVEST criteria. User stories should deliver a vertical slice of functionality to the customer that is valuable and complete by the end of an iteration.
