SECTION 13. ALTERATION OF MEMORANDUM. [Effective from 1st April, 2014] (1) Save as provided in section 61, a company may, by a special resolution and after complying with the procedure specified in this section, alter the provisions of its memorandum. This legal update summarizes (1) the reporting requirements under Section 13 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the “ Exchange Act”), which are generally applicable to persons that own, or exercise investment discretion over accounts that own, publicly traded or exchange listed equity securities, and (2) the reporting requirements under Section 16 of the Exchange Act, which are applicable to persons considered to be “insiders” of public companies.

10/16/2020. § 13.1-706. Amendment of articles of incorporation by the board of directors. A. Where no shares of the corporation are issued and outstanding, a corporation's board of directors may adopt an amendment of the corporation's articles of incorporation without shareholder approval. B. Unless the articles of incorporation provide otherwise, a corporation's board of directors may adopt amendments of the corporation's articles of incorporation without shareholder approval:

Cooling-Off Period upon a change in investment purpose. Qualified Institutional Investors: 10 day period after the filing of a Schedule 13D because the person no longer holds the securities in the ordinary course of business or not with the purpose or effect of changing or influencing control of the issuer. Effects of Amendments to Regulation 13D-G

§ 13.1-834. Change of registered office or registered agent. A. A corporation may change its registered office or registered agent, or both, upon filing with the Commission a statement of change on a form prescribed and furnished by the Commission that sets forth: 1. The name of the corporation; 2. The address of its current registered office; 3.

§ 13.1-834. Change of registered office or registered agent

That after the change or changes are made, the domestic or foreign limited liability company will be in compliance with the requirements of § 13.1-1015. B. A statement of change shall forthwith be filed with the Commission by a domestic or foreign limited liability company whenever its registered agent dies, resigns or ceases to satisfy the requirements of § 13.1-1015 .

§ 13.1-1016. Change of registered office or registered agent

Under Section 13(d)(3) of the Exchange Act, the group is treated as a new "person" for purposes of Section 13(d)(1), and the group is deemed to have acquired, by operation of Rule 13d-5(b), beneficial ownership of the shares beneficially owned by its members. (Note that the analysis is different for Section 16 purposes.

That after the change or changes are made, the corporation will be in compliance with the requirements of § 13.1-763. B. A statement of change shall be filed with the Commission by a foreign corporation if its registered agent dies, resigns, or ceases to satisfy the requirements of § 13.1-763.

§ 13.1-764. (Effective July 1, 2021) Change of registered ...

Section 13 of the Canadian Human Rights Act was a provision of the Canadian Human Rights Act (CHRA) dealing with hate messages. The provision prohibited online communications which were

"likely to expose a person or persons to hatred or contempt" on the basis of a prohibited ground of discrimination (such as race, national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, etc.).
