Basic Texas Purchaser Course. A state agency employee must complete the Basic Texas Purchaser Course to engage in purchasing functions on behalf of a state agency if the employee has the job title of "purchaser"; performs purchasing activities as fifteen percent (15%) or more of their job activities; or makes a purchase in excess of \$5,000.

Article III. This article established the Supreme Court and authorizes Congress to establish lower federal courts. The types of cases the courts have jurisdiction over are given, and a provision is made for the right to trial by jury. While not specifically stated, the power of the courts to declare a law unconstitutional is implied. Article IV
