Frank Zhang, a former Centurion of the Fifth Cohort Historically, Centurion (centurio in Latin) was a professional officer (one of the Ordinarii) in the Roman army. Most centurions commanded eighty men (a Century) despite the commonly assumed one hundred, but senior centurions (the Centurio Primus Pilus for example) commanded cohorts, or took senior staff roles in their legion.
