In Canada, the recommended amount of fluoride is 0.7 mg/L in drinking water for communities that wish to add fluoride to their water supply.

Fluoride analyzer. After the dosing point, a water sample should be directed to a fluoride analyzer. This analyzer is an ISE (Ion Selective Electrode) and measures free fluoride (F⁻).
