To make the meringue, lower the oven temperature to 250 °F (120 °C). In a mixer, beat the egg whites at medium speed for 1 minute, until a white

froth with large bubbles forms. Gradually, add the sugar and beat until stiff and shiny. On a sheet of parchment paper, draw a rectangle the size of the baking pan.
