In the 2005–2006 NSCSHCN with different criteria for the transition process, 41.2% of parents reported that youth met standards for transition (any one of first three and the fourth): (1) the doctor or other health care provider discussed changing to an adult provider (41.9%) (relevant for youth receiving care from pediatric-only providers); (2) the doctor discussed adult health care needs ...
