You should use SP-III transmission fluid, which is available to buy from your dealer. The Hyundai Accent takes seven quarts of fluid. Let the fluid settle for five minutes, and then put the dipstick in and pull it out. Look at the fluid level on the end of the dipstick. The fluid should be at the highest hash mark on the end.

Fluid should trickle out very slightly and slowly. If so, the fluid level is fine. If not, add a very little bit of fluid at a time into the funnel placed in the fill plug. If you have to add fluid, lower the Golf down on the lift low enough to add fluid but still high enough above the drain bucket.

Of course, you should check your owner's manual first to make sure DOT 4 can be used in your vehicle. DOT 5 fluid is silicone-based: It doesn't absorb moisture like DOT 3 and 4 fluids do, and it has a higher boiling point. However, DOT 5 fluid should never be added to vehicles that specify DOT 3 or 4 fluid, as brake system damage can occur.

Diesel Exhaust Fluid or DEF for short, is a mixture of 32.5% Urea (for the ones that like chemistry: $(\text{NH}_2)_2\text{CO}$) and 67.5% de-ionised water. How does diesel exhaust fluid work? It is injected into the exhaust stream, where it's water evaporates. The separation of Urea and Water due to heat, is called thermolysis.
