"A teaching (philosophy) statement is a purposeful and reflective essay about the author's teaching beliefs and practices. It is an individual narrative that includes not only one's beliefs about the teaching and learning process but also concrete examples of the ways in which he or she enacts these beliefs in the classroom."

## **Suggestions for Writing a Philosophy Statement**

Simply put, a philosophy of teaching statement is a personal proclamation of your goals and aspirations as a teacher, the methods you intend to use to meet these goals, how you plan to assess student understanding, and how you will improve and adapt your teaching.

## **How to Write a Philosophy of Teaching Statement—Tips**

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Your teaching philosophy should reflect your personal values and beliefs about teaching. It is a self-reflective statement that describes both what you believe and provides concrete examples of what you do in the classroom to support those beliefs. It is written in first person and should convey a professional image of your teaching.

The statement should reflect your core values and beliefs in terms of teaching. Consider your thoughts regarding the nature of children, the purpose of education and how people learn, and the role of teacher. ## **Sample Philosophy Statements**

A statement of teaching philosophy is a flexible document, and can be successfully constructed in a number of different ways. One way is to include descriptions of specific teaching strategies (e.g., a description of a particular assignment or class activity) alongside your teaching beliefs.

A philosophy of education statement is an opportunity to define what teaching means to you, and to describe how and why you teach as you do. Articulating this statement in the first person and using a traditional essay format (introduction, body, conclusion) will help you craft an enduring and inspiring personal statement.

## **Philosophy of Education Examples for Elementary Teachers**

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Writing Your Teaching Philosophy. Your teaching philosophy is a self-reflective statement of your beliefs about teaching and learning. It's a one to two page narrative that conveys your core ideas about being an effective teacher in the context of your discipline. It develops these ideas with specific, concrete examples of what the teacher and learners will do to achieve those goals.

## **Leadership Philosophy Examples to Help You Write Your Own ...**

Do include a title, an introduction that presents the purpose of your statement, and a conclusion that ideally leaves a powerful image or idea with your reader. Alexander et. al. (2017) argue for a “remediation” of the teaching philosophy statement that integrates the teaching technologies with which we already work.

## **How to Write a Philosophy of Teaching Statement | Top Hat**

There are instructors who are able to write wonderful philosophy statements that use metaphors thematically throughout the document, continually tying the components back to that metaphor. Other use metaphors only in the philosophy

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development stages, using it as a tool to help them better articulate their ideas, rather than actually writing the metaphor in the final document.

### **Guidance on Writing a Philosophy of Teaching Statement - UCAT**

Teaching philosophy statements are an integral component of a education portfolio. This statement helps to demonstrate how you have been purposeful about your teaching. It also enables you to communicate your goals as a teacher and illustrate how your teaching concepts can be transformed into real classroom activities.

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
