High levels can indicate that a child has a higher risk of developing type 1 diabetes. If you think your child might have type 1 diabetes, contact your doctor. If a member of your family has type 1 diabetes, you may be eligible for a risk screening offered through the TrialNet Pathway to Prevention Study. TrialNet risk screening is free to relatives of people with type 1, and uses a simple blood test that can detect your risk of type 1 diabetes years before symptoms appear.

If your child has low blood sugar, you may notice: Pale or gray skin; Moodiness; Clumsiness; Confusion; Your child might tell you that he: Feels shaky or dizzy; Gets headaches; Struggles to see ...

How You Can Find Out If Your Child Has Blood Sugar Problems

One of the early signs of diabetes in children is increased urination and thirst. When blood-sugar is high it triggers a reaction in the body that pulls fluid from tissues. This will leave your son or daughter constantly thirsty, resulting in a need for more bathroom breaks throughout the day.

How Did You Know Your Child Had Type 1 Diabetes?

Other children might experience: Increased thirst and frequent urination. Excess sugar building up in your child's bloodstream pulls fluid from tissues. Fatigue. Lack of sugar in your child's cells might make him or her exhausted. Blurry vision. If your child's blood sugar is too high, fluid may be ...

Could Your Child Have Diabetes? | Parents

If you have gestational diabetes, your baby could be at higher risk for health problems. Gestational diabetes usually goes away after your baby is born but increases your risk for type 2 diabetes later in life. Your baby is more likely to have obesity as a child or teen, and more likely to develop type 2 diabetes later in life too.

Juvenile diabetes, better known as type 1 diabetes or insulin-dependent diabetes, is a disease in which the pancreas, which normally produces insulin, stops producing insulin. Insulin is important because it's a hormone that regulates the amount of sugar (glucose) in the blood and helps to transfer the glucose to your cells for energy.

Your child will need regular follow-up appointments to ensure good diabetes management and to check his or her A1C levels. The American Diabetes Association generally recommends an A1C of 7.5 or lower for all children and teens. Your doctor also will periodically check your child's:
